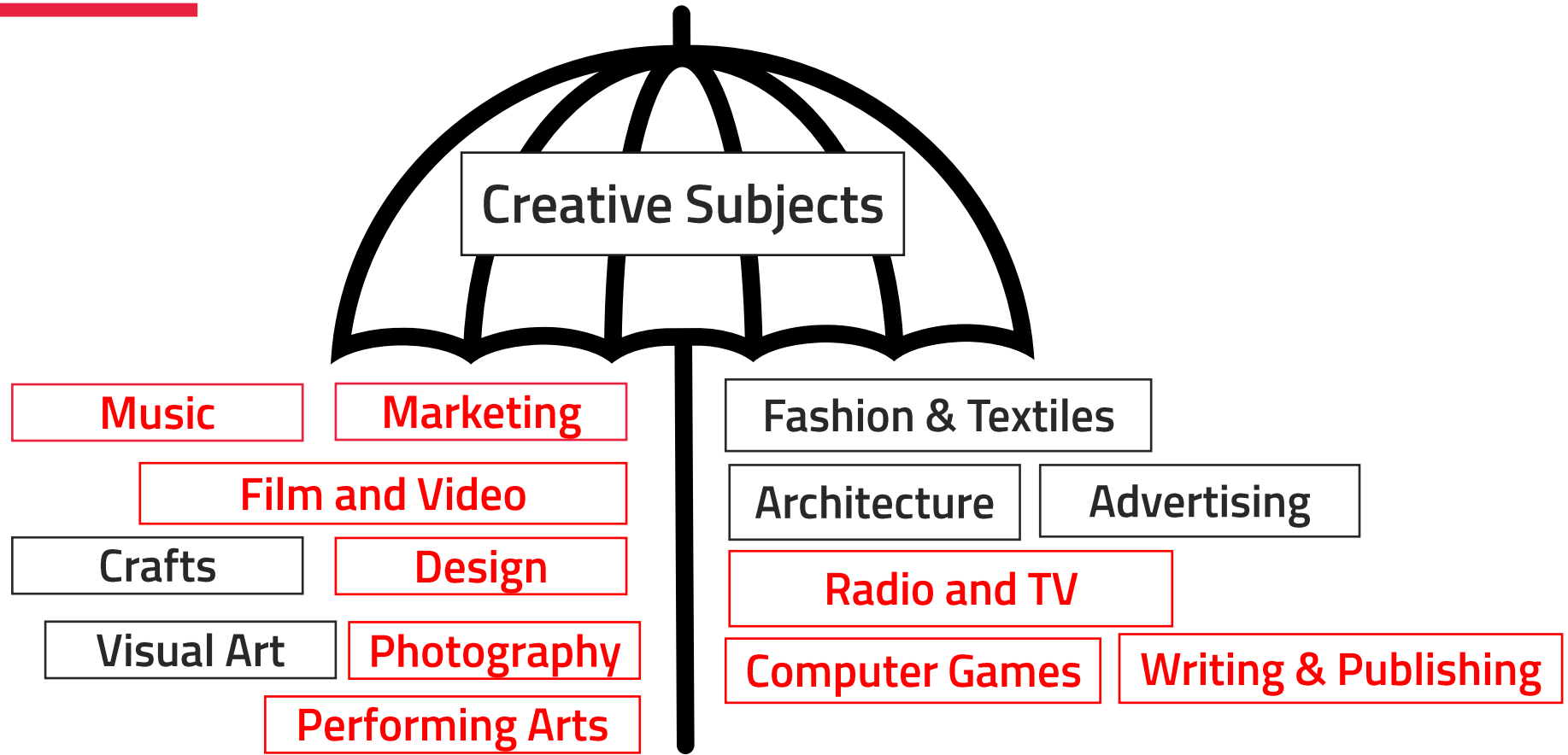

What are Creative Subjects?



Creative subjects or the Creative Industries describe roles or areas which has creativity, skill and talent at the heart of what they do.

Why the Creative Industries?



- **The Creative Industries boost the Economy**
 - *The Creative Industries is one of the major growth areas in the UK economy, boasting more than £92 billion in UK income. In Scotland it is £4.6 billion to the economy.*
- **The Creative Industries employ a lot of people**
 - *In Scotland the creative industries comprise over 15,000 businesses employing more 70,000 people, in addition to a large number of freelancers as well as students studying creative courses.*
- **The Creative Industries can make our lives better**
 - *Studies show that people who have attended a cultural place or event in the previous 12 months are almost 60 per cent more likely to report good health compared to those who have not*
- **The Creative Industries can broaden your horizons and introduce new prospective**
 - *They send a message to the world that Scotland is a place where creativity thrives, producing internationally renowned work, sending our home-grown talent out into the world and drawing international talent to come here. For example, there has been a 66% increase in the number of film and video companies based in Scotland over the past decade as the draw for different film backgrounds increases.*
